Subject: Feedback on TPS

Good afternoon,

I am writing to provide feedback on the draft TPS.

The draft document does not fulfill the key mandate of the Islands Trust to "preserve and protect" the unique Trust Area for residents and all British Columbians.

Whereas the current TPS explicitly lays out a commitment to limit growth and development, the draft TPS merely has a vague promise to "manage development".

Despite being mentioned many times, the word "environment" is inexplicably not defined - a considerable oversight that compromises the integrity of the whole document.

Troublingly, there is no commitment in the draft TPS to ensure that any new density is devoted to genuinely affordable housing, rather than market-driven development.

The draft TPS is untenable, and as such I hope that the province does not approve it.
