Subject: Draft TPS. Does not carry out the mandate of the islands trust

I am concerned that the draft TPS does not carry out the mandate of the Trust. The Trust Policy Statement should include the following:

- Protecting the islands from over-development by enforcing island **limits on growth and development**, as the current TPS does, not “manage development” as stated in the draft TPS.
- **Define the word “Environment” as referring to the natural ecological environment.** Although used throughout the document, this word is not defined.
- Wetlands, riparian areas, **all types of marine and land-based native ecosystems** should be protected against further degradation and adverse impacts of development.
- **Directives should be mandatory** or the document is little more than advice that islands can disregard.
- A Directive (requirement) is needed to assure that increases in density for affordable and workforce housing, means housing with **binding agreements** to assure affordability.
