Dear Trustees: Thanks for your work. Below are my views on TPS draft:

- Draft is significantly weaker than current 2021 TPS and does NOT carry out the ecological Mandate of Preserve and Protect. It gives more support for people than land, trees, lakes and ocean.
- Enforce limits on growth and development- “manage development” to weak a phrase. Must be actual limits on growth and development.
- Define word “Environment”- refers to natural world of Nature not people.
- Native Ecosystems like wetlands, riparian areas must be protected from further degradation and adverse effects of development.
- All Directives must be Mandatory.
- “Unique Amenities- housing, tourism, infrastructure, are not equal and must not override Preserve and Protect mandate.
