I am a Salt Spring Island resident of many decades, and would like to register my dismay at the aggressive changes which I see proposed and unfolding under the auspices of the current Trust Council. I do not agree with the growth-and-development-forward agenda set out in the "new" Trust Policy Statement.

Abiding by the original intentions of the Islands Trust Act, our elected representatives must consider the unique natural, physical character of the gulf islands region, and protect its integrity. The protection of this still-vital ecological area must be the basis for all amendments and decisions made by the Islands Trust. The proposed changes to policy will not advance - and may well undermine - the foundational and critical ecological mandate of the Islands Trust.
