Concerning the motions of trustee Pottle, to go no further with the Crystal Mounrain proposal, and trustee Harris's motion, to consider covenant only approvals for forest rezoning, at the Feb. LTC meeting;

The confusion at the March LTC meeting concerning the minutes of the FEB. meeting, as the minutes showed both motions seconded and defeated, was obvious. When the minutes were being corrected to read that the Motion from trustee Harris had not been seconded, I had to leave for fear of loosing my composure. To make the minutes of a public meeting misrepresent the truth corrupts the integrity of the whole process.

At the meeting of the LTC in February. I distinctly remember that trustee Pottle's motion to go no further with the crystal mountain rezoning was not seconded.

Further, when the staff were instructed to bring back bylaws to represent what trustee Harris's motion would look like, the reason becomes clear. How would that make sense if the original motion had been debated and defeated by the chair.

Confusion about the history of the meetings can cause huge embarrassment and or huge mistakes. Future meeting minutes would benefit from meetings being recorded electronically.

Trustee Harris has made comments publicly about his experience when rezoning a forest lot that clearly biases him with regard to the rezoning process and so is cause to recuse himself from all discussions and decisions concerning the forest zone on Galiano.

Also note the the request to get a legal opinion of the consequence of the shift in policy on the Galiano forest zone and the PMFL was made after strong lobbying by previous local trustees.
