

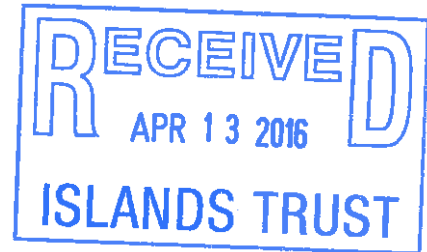

I do not support the creation of huts for human habitation in any zone which does not contain a residential provision. Although the proposed model has much merit in providing modest shelter for people it is still a residential use. It is irrelevant that a special interest group seeks to rezone for this use-what people do in their "huts" is what people do. The concept of creating "tiny home" "communes" or "villages" is intriguing and worth exploring in order to address our chronic housing shortage and to replace or enhance existing "dwellings" which are substandard and not legal but are used for human habitation. There likely exists ideal sites for this purpose on parcels of land not currently zoned for residential use including some Forest and Agriculture zoned lands and the subject may be one such site but let's call it what it is-an application to create a new model of residential zoning.
