As a long time serving member of the Hornby Island Fire dept I do not want to see a cell tower installed near my place of work.

I am concerned with the health issues around cell towers and do not want to be exposed when I am required to be at the fire hall.

As a resident of Hornby I feel the the island does not need this service and it is not wanted here.

There a a few small areas that lack service but this is to be expected of a rural area.

To conclude I do not support the install of a cell tower on Hornby Island.

Islands Trust need to make sure there is adequate public engagement on Hornby before any decision is made. There is also no mention of First Nations engagement in their application.
