





Water Sustainability Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use, and store water as follows:

- a) The source on which the rights are granted is from unconsolidated material and storage is in a dugout.
- b) The point of groundwater diversion is located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 14, 2018.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are industrial (commercial enterprise).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and used for industrial (commercial enterprise) purpose is 3 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be diverted into storage is the whole year and the stored water may be used for industrial (commercial enterprise) during the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1, Section 18, Pender Island, Cowichan District, Plan VIP59806.
- h) The authorized works are tank, pipe, pump, and dugout which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- k) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing under the *Water Sustainability Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in a stream for maintaining the health of aquatic ecosystems.
