#### PURPOSE

This memo introduces two discussion papers for the LUB Review Project and updates the LTC on the status of the project.

The project was identified by LTC in late 2019 and the project charter was endorsed in January (project charter attached). The objective of the project is to implement Official Community Plan (OCP) policies through amendments to the Land Use Bylaw (LUB). The project encompasses 7 topic areas:

- 1. Residential floor area review.
- 2. Conservation subdivision review.
- 3. Tourist Commercial regulation review.
- 4. Marine shoreline regulations review.
- 5. Agricultural regulations amendments.
- 6. Industrial regulation review.
- 7. Minor and technical amendments

For the initial phase (Feb – June), the project charter identifies that staff will undertake a review of the topics and issues, and prepare background material and options for consideration. For the May 21st meeting agenda staff have prepared discussion papers on two topics: Residential Floor Area and Industrial Land Uses. There is also background on the Conservation Subdivision topic available on <u>the previous projects webpage</u> from 2013-14 (staff will also be compiling and summarizing this information). The purpose of the discussion papers is to provide policy and regulatory context, identify issues with the current regulations, and provide some options that can potentially be implemented through LUB amendments.

#### **NEXT STEPS**

At this point, the LTC can receive the discussion papers, and should identify if there is any additional information that should be added or areas that should be expanded upon.

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Additional background work on the other topic areas is scheduled for receipt at the next LTC meeting. Staff are optimistic that most of the analysis can be completed by the next meeting, but the LTC should be aware that the southern team is short one Island Planner position until mid-July, which may affect the project timeline

Once the background analysis phase of the project is complete, the LTC will be asked to consider consultation options in detail. Options for consultation are currently uncertain due to the Covid-19 emergency.

As the LTC receives discussion papers, they will also be posted to the project webpage.

## Purpose: project to consider implementation of a OCP policies through amendments to the Land Use Bylaw

**Background:** The current OCP was adopted in 2007. Subsequently a number of amendments have been made to both the OCP and LUB that implemented some policies in the OCP, however there has not been a comprehensive review of the Land Use Bylaw to implement all relevant policies and initiatives in the OCP, nor to update the LUB for technical and minor amendments.
