Subject: 434 Baker road beach revetment

Dear Salt Spring Islands Trust,

I'm writing about File No.: PLDVP20250460 X-File: PLDP20250452

Until very recently I was unaware of the application for a Development Variance Permit at 434 Baker Road, SSI. I thought that I'd been watching your site but somehow never saw this.

I'm concerned about how far the proposed rock revetment would cover the upper shoreline if it was allowed.

The drawings by Ryzuk Geotechnical appear to show that the revetment would cover 2.5 metres in front of the present natural boundary. I believe that could make it very difficult for anyone wanting to walk northward from the Baker Rd. steps except at medium-to-low tides. Perhaps I'm wrong. But I know the revetment at 241 Quarry Drive stops anyone walking the beach if the tide is higher than 10ft. I've lived here 43 years and don't want to see that mistake repeated.
