The constant changes to the plans for this property is very upsetting. The increased traffic and water usage concerns are valid. The junction of Blain and Lower Ganges Roads is extremely accident prone. It appears that no one has considered the impact this type of project would have on the area and we are unaware of any studies or interest in that regard. Not once have we been approached about these changes. The only time we were considered, was initially, when Miles Wilson came by with information and drawings for the lower density option which we were glad to support.
