Local Trustee Activities

March 15 – **Squamish Council leadership gathering**. The Local Trust Committee and CAO Russ Hotsenpillar attended this consolidated gathering of locally elected representatives within the territory of the Squamish at the Joe Mathias centre in North Vancouver. Several Skwxwú7mesh council members were in attendance along with about 80 other municipal and regional reps and staff. We conducted round table discussions about various challenges in terms of connecting appropriately with the Nation, the Squamish Council, and visa-versa. I did bring up the New Brighton dock several times, but it was not a venue for specific results. The dock is on the agenda for an Islands Trust Executive/staff meeting with Squamish Council members on April 8th. I will be attending this meeting as well primarily to discuss the New Brighton dock and the necessary community engagement around its future.

March 25th – Presented at the Baynes Sound/Lambert Channel Forum in Courtenay. I gave a presentation about the history and initiatives of the Howe Sound Community Forum and the Ocean Watch Task Force. The Baynes Sound area is looking at options for regional engagement to support their unique and highly productive marine area.

Islands Trust Council

Trust Council March 13-15th - was held on Gabriola. **The 2019-2020 budget** was passed with a 2% increase to the IT portion of property taxes and included more money to the Islands Trust Conservancy. No increase is considered lightly by the council as we recognize the Trust portion of the annual property tax is just one of several line items on a property owners annual bill.
