I am writing to object to the lack of public consultation for this draft policy. I understand that less than 1,000 people took part in some sort of consultation process as well as private conversations with First Nations that are not available to the public. COVID19 and the isolation of the last 15 months or so left a considerable number of people uninformed about this Draft Policy and the first reading that is to be taking place.

The first reading of the draft policy should be postponed until public consultation in person on all the Islands can occur.

The IT is not representing me or a great many other people in the Trust area regarding this so called revision of the policy. This draft policy reads like a new policy which when understood means Islands Trust is going to effectively do away with the OCP of each of the islands in the Trust area and supplant them with their POLICY. I strenuously oppose this draft policy.

After all is said and done the Islands Trust is supposed to represent the people of the Trust area not take away our democratic rights with a "you know best attitude". I wonder if this draft policy was a "make work project" to justify the Islands Trust's existence in it's present form.
