Thank you so much for your speedy reply, and access to that document.

I am personally very concerned about -

4.6.14 - as I commute to work by boat and do not have a dock.

I will explain my personal situation since I assume (perhaps incorrectly) the majority of new dock applications are desired for recreational purposes. I was hoping to submit a dock application in the near future for parking for my boat which is my vehicle for commuting to work. As you may know I work on Salt Spring and reside on Galiano.

I am lucky enough to have neighbours at the moment who allow me use of their dock. However, as my once full time resident neighbours have both passed away and I am actively watching their children fix the place up to sell I'm increasingly seeing the necessity of access to new moorage options.

Without meaningful access to a community dock (montague for example has a multi-year wait list for full time moorage) I (and others) may be unable to continue commuting between the island for essential travel (in my case - employment).

The prohibition of all private docks on Galiano without the existence of either

- 1. Meaningful inter-island ferry services &
- 2. Access to moorage services seems unacceptable and short sited.
