On Mayne, what consultation there was on this proposal took place during the garbage collection issue and ended up being only noise. I don't understand the haste to move this proposal through. It's as if there is an unknown agenda by certain trustees within the council. Jeanine, the disbanding of the auxiliaries from the MIFR and the resulting fallout was a result of moving too fast. I was on MIID board at the time and saw the damage that was done to people and relationships.

Also, a comment on presentations to the council, to have the council pre-approve text of any presentation is effectively a gag order. This may be allowed under the rules but is just not right.
