a group of residents on North Pender are meeting this week to discuss the proposed policy bylaw 183. Our first comment is “Why is it impossible to find the policy revision document on the IT website?”

After a wasted 45 minutes on the IT website we found it by calling the Victoria office and having a staff member direct us to it by clicking on the June 15th date on a calendar and there it is, buried in a meeting agenda.

If Islands Trust is truly committed to open and transparent communications, this very important document would be prominently displayed on the home page.

Even a search of the IT documents library fails to find this document... because as your staff member mentioned, it is not yet a document, only a part of meeting agenda documents.

This is absurd and unfortunately leads to dark suspicions that the Trust is deliberately trying to hide something from the public and implement secret changes. That likely is not true but actions and behaviours speak loudly.

Please fix this problem quickly before more negative opinions are formed even before folks actually read the document,
