- WITH STORES, DAYCARE, SERVICES.
(CENTRAL SEWAGE, POWER UTILITIES ETC)
 - GRID SYSTEM, RENEWABLE POWER (SOLAR, WIND)
 - Keep 1 house (any size) + 1 guest cabin (4600 PER 102000) but remove restrictions on guest cabin \rightarrow more affordable housing. +1
 - Covenant land on Southend to allow Northend cluster (swap density)
 - Higher standards for clustered "ecovillages" incl. car-free or car-reduced, low-emission high-efficiency wood heat, insulation, water, energy

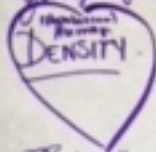

Carbon footprints - education...
action. 24 hr. diesel burning, wood stoves, what's the real footprint?

- Waste repurposing cooperative: refabrication, refinishing, etc.

- ENCOURAGE CREATIVITY & INDEPENDANT THINKING
- SUPPORT LOCAL ENTREPRENEURS
- THINK GLOBAL (eg. internet based, or global impact, big ideas with universal impact)
- MORE AFFORDABLE HOUSING WILL STIMULATE LOCAL ECONOMY → MORE JOBS WILL RESULT
- REALISTIC EXPECTATIONS FOR A SMALL COASTAL COMMUNITY.

- think global (eg. internet based, or global impact, big ideas with universal impact)
- more affordable housing will stimulate local economy → more jobs will result
- realistic expectations for a small coastal community. (we are used to seasonal work, many jobs, jobs elsewhere, money spent here)
- you are not entitled !!
- community support education of islanders who want to go off & return (educated) - I disagree → just pay to the laborer, what?
- communications (telecom) can be unpredictable.
- allow home enterprise to hire other people. yes!
- allow spot zoning for creative ideas. X2
- apply for community economic devel. grant from Prov. (community infrastructure, application from a group of local entrepreneurs. - yes!)
- housing for employees on your property.
- 10 ac. can have house + 600 sf. (can't rent, more)
