## CREATE VILLAGES IN DOWNTOWN AREA

- WITH STORES, DAYCARE, SERVICES.  
(CENTRAL SQUARE, POWER, UTILITIES ETC)
- GRID SYSTEM, RENEWABLE POWER (SOLAR, WIND)







## Encourage Native Plants

of habitat" (Quote from S Biology here to study  
native plants / animals - ) (Bull Frogs are #2)  
(Shape ponds with sloping sides to discourage Bull Frogs!)

removal of slimy fibreglass  
boats left in water's!

STEEP OVERPOPULATION DESTROYS FORESTS,  
NATIVE PLANTS. Yes!

- 7 Do a Watershed plan to establish  
essential corridors in the water  
system (network of ponds, streams, lakes,  
and habitat. Preserve & raise awareness  
for essentials on private & public land.
  - Focus on the health of 'The Commons'  
crown lands, water, etc.
  - Lasqueti is the last remaining stand of the  
Coastal Douglas Fir ecosystem on the planet!

Round up the sheep and severely limit the population, or eliminate. They are an invasive species.

Round up humans, they are an invasive species.

Carbon footprints - education... action. 24 hr. diesel burning, wood stoves, what's the real footprint?

- waste repurposing cooperative: refabrication, refurbishing, etc.
- limit the number of wood-burning stoves! Go green energy heater!!!

Community support for better wood stoves, less-stinky vehicles, insulate homes, etc.

How to incentivize??

- aim to reduce our eco-footprint through reduced consumption

- every "development" has to have a plan to deal with waste, for water, + renewable power!
- marijuana production → 24 hr use of diesel generators = huge carbon footprint

## "LOCAL ECONOMY & JOBS"

- LET THE LABOUR CODE BE THE MINIMUM!
- keep open to all possibilities (not restrict)
- encourage creativity & independent thinking
- support local entrepreneurship
- think global (eg. internet based, or global impact, big ideas with universal impact)
- more affordable housing will stimulate local economy → more jobs will result
- realistic expectations for a small coastal community
  - no need to seasonal work - annual jobs
