Additionally, the Tribe reserves the right to address issues related to Aboriginal rights, title infringement, and compensation through appropriate channels such as treaty negotiations, judicial processes, or alternative dispute resolution mechanisms. The Tribe also retains the right to raise objections if cultural sites, archaeological resources, or environmental impacts are identified during development activities, or if unforeseen impacts on rights or interests are discovered.
