My name is Lorrie Irwin and I am the [REDACTED] and have been since [REDACTED]. I have serious concerns regarding the rezoning application SS-RZ 2017.3 for 2188 North End Rd. It is my understanding that there is no septic system for the dwelling that is classed as a workshop but is in fact [REDACTED] rented. I also have grave concerns regarding drainage from this property into the surrounding wells, Weisner Creek and the subsequent drainage into the McFadden Creek tributary which runs through the length of [REDACTED] property. It is inconceivable that the Trust would allow the rezoning to go ahead without proper testing and against the recommendations of the planners involved.
