Please do not give first reading to bylaw 528

There has not been public awareness or information of how these changes could be accommodated, the impact on resources, eg water, and services, eg .health care, fire, police, ferries, roads, etc

The present OCP was arrived at with great care and effort. It should remain in effect.

A population cap of 17,000 is already high for this small island with its limited resources, any possible increase is probably unsustainable.

I don't see bylaw 528 addressing the need for low cost long term accommodation for people who work here in service industries, health care etc.
