Without specific groundwater testing of all such building sites this cannot be known.

Is it sustainable, a reliable supply into the indefinite future of global warming climate?

The duration and degree of continuing climate warming is not known.

When it does peak it is likely to be slower in decline than during the temperature rising period.

Well failure already is a common occurrence. already.

Salt Spring's climate is well defined by its long, dry summers.

The most essential thing Salt Spring Islands Trust can do
is to eliminate the 5000 future growth provision,
and to err on the side of caution rather than crisis.
