To the South Pender Local Trust Committee

We are aware that you are planning to review Bylaw #122 and we are writing to request that you review each of the proposed changes before making decisions about changing or deleting them. I know that you realize that you are elected as "Trustees" to preserve and protect our island as one of the islands in the Islands Trust area — you are not councillors, or district directors, or mayors. So - please review the changes with the lens of preserving and protecting South Pender from over development — that doesn't mean that you can't make any changes, rather that I would ask that you make any adjustments to the bylaw with the preserve and protect lens in mind. In a situation where the regulations do not fit a particular lot, then the owner of the lot can always file a variance request so that they may be allowed to build if appropriate and if acceptable to near neighbours.
